The Westmoreland County Area Labor-Management Committee offers an annual scholarship to a Westmoreland County resident pursuing a degree from an accredited educational institution in **industrial & labor relations, human resource management, business, public administration, pre-law, or other closely related field.**

WCALMC is an advocate for labor-management cooperation in Western Pennsylvania and seeks to assist qualified students with costs associated in the pursuit of an undergraduate degree in a labor relations field.

SCHOLARSHIP:

The WCALMC Annual Scholarship is a one-time cash award in the amount of \$500. The award is given to a Westmoreland County resident with a genuine interest in labor relations and a desire to foster positive labor-management relationships and cooperation in Pennsylvania.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- Be a Westmoreland County resident.
- Be a high school senior enrolling in an undergraduate labor relations-related program at an accredited educational institution.
- Submit the WCALMC scholarship application by **April 8, 2009.**
- Submit high school transcripts, which include overall GPA.
- Include a letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, or other professional.
- Finalists will be asked to participate in an interview with Committee members to discuss career aspirations, reasons for choosing to study labor relations, etc.
- The winner will be awarded the scholarship at the WCALMC Annual Golf Outing in July.
